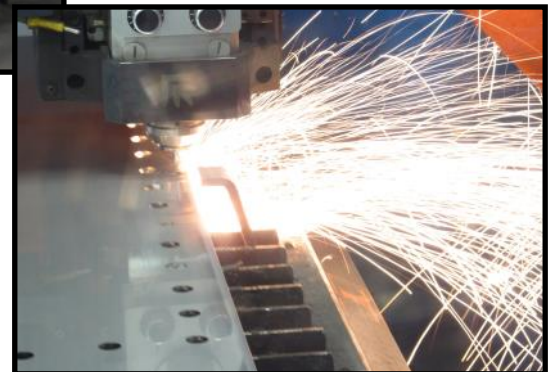

## **AISI Releases November SIMA Imports Data**

American Iron and Steel Institute (AISI) provides import data for the monthly Steel Import Monitoring and Analysis (SIMA) Reports.

In November, steel imports totaled 2,544,000 net tons (NT). This was a 15.4% decrease compared to October levels.
