Wisconsin Receives \$61M For Drinking Water, Wastewater Improvements

Wisconsin is getting more than \$61.7 million from the federal government to fund improvements to water and wastewater infrastructure through the state's revolving loan programs.

Last year, the state awarded \$123 million in lowinterest loans for wastewater projects in 44 communities across Wisconsin. The state provided \$57 million in loans to 32 municipalities for drinking water projects last year.

Gov. Tony Evers has declared 2019 as the year of clean drinking water in Wisconsin.
