## Menomonie's Community for Veterans receives Rotary grant.

The Community for Veterans (C4V) provides short-term housing for veterans while attending school, looking for employment or obtaining medical treatment in the Menomonie area. Seeing a need for this type of facility in Dunn County for many

years, Earl Wildenberg developed it from a residence that he owned. Private rooms, cooking areas and laundry facilities are available here. This grant award is a \$5,000 match to funds awarded by the Menomonie Sunrise Rotary Club. The \$10,000 will be used to build another apartment at the facility. Over the past 2 years many renovations have occurred at the C4V



home including updates to all three bathrooms and the addition of two bedrooms.
